Established in 1815, Allegheny College is one of the oldest 1% of US colleges and occupies land along both sides of Route 86 (North Main Street) in the town of Meadville, Pennsylvania. In addition to their main campus, this private college also owns a 182-acre recreational complex approximately one mile north of the main campus as well as a 238-acre environmental studies field station.

The campus is composed of many buildings which date from the late-1880s and early 1900s. However, during the 1950s, 60s, and 70s, the college renovated and expanded many of these buildings and also constructed new ones.

In the past decade, Allegheny College—which is one of the oldest colleges in the United States—has implemented a comprehensive construction program for new and renovated facilities which has included residence halls, recreational facilities, and classroom/laboratory space. The current Carr Hall renovation utilizes a design/build approach.
